## Continuing Conversations at Home:

* Math: Ask: What is the difference between the words "taller" and "longer"?
-Taller describes the measurement of height (up and down). Longer describes the measurement of length (side to side).

Ask: Why is it important to use a start line when comparing the length of items?
-Placing all items on a common start line makes it easier to compare.

## Notes:

- Grove's Family Reading Program: Firstgrade students are expected to read for 30 minutes each day now that the family reading program has kicked off. Not only did the students meet the class goal of 3,780 minutes, they surpassed the goal by nearly 1,000 minutes. A few students even read over 300 minutes. Wow!
